Cardiology specialists keep abreast of the most current diagnostic and therapeutic options and will be a continued resource for you and your clients beyond the initial consult. The cardiologist can often work with you to review recheck radiographs and lab work performed at your office for follow-up of cardiology patients (fee applies).

MINIMALLY-INVASIVE CARDIAC PROCEDURES

Minimally invasive (fluoroscopic-guided) pacemaker placement, intravascular PDA occlusion, and balloon valvuloplasty.

PUPPIES GALORE

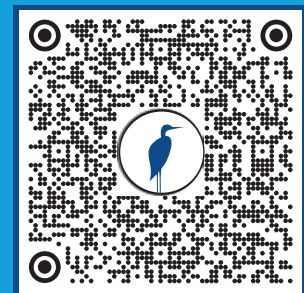
Sire, dam, and puppy cardiology evaluations will be offered 2 days per month for breeders.
